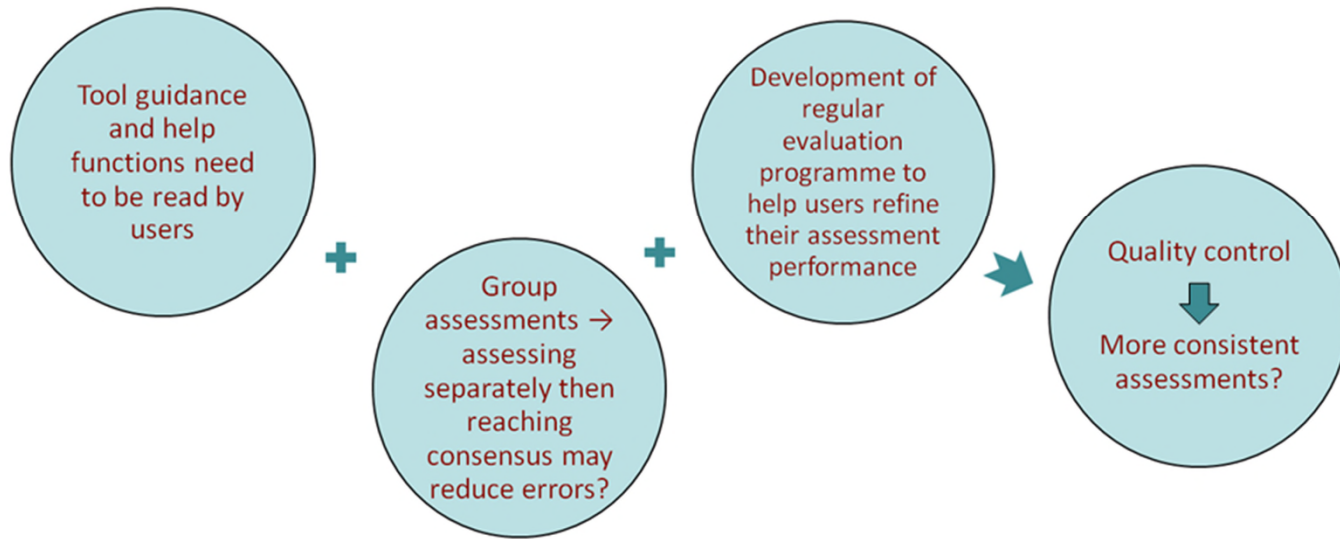

Summary



- Tools appear to be conservative, but not necessary for all exposure categories
 - However, what level of conservatism is sufficient?
 - What is the likelihood that false-negative conclusions are drawn?
- Apart from powders (TRAvs2 and vs3 and STM) correlations with measurement results was low or absent.
- More data required for non-volatile, metal abrasion and hot metal processes, but limited data suggest that tools should be used very cautiously for these
