Stoffenmanager supports companies with their inventory of risks due to working with hazardous substances. Stoffenmanager helps companies to identify: where are my risks and which work situations are adequately controlled? The tool has the following features:

- A control banding module to assess the risk through inhalation and skin exposure.
- Calculates worker inhalation exposure levels and instantly shows the effects of control measures (cost effective).
- An overview of the risk assessment with selected control measures depicted in an action plan.
- The REACH-user route, which is linked to **European Chemical Agency's (ECHA) Chemical Safety Assessment and Reporting (CHESAR) tool**
- CLP (EU-GHS compatibility).
- Worker educational material, like short PIMEX-movies and instruction cards.

The platform has more than 20,000 users with an average increase of 150-200 users per month and 35% of the visits to Stoffenmanager is coming from outside the Netherlands. Currently the free version of Stoffenmanager is available through www.stoffenmanager.nl in English, Dutch, Finnish (FIOH) and German (full integration in preparation, IFA). In addition a premium version is available with more functionalities for larger enterprises and for the REACH registration process.

Stoffenmanager is an example of international cooperation through the spreading and implementation of successful solutions over boundaries. The International Scientific Advisory Board has a leading role in future developments of the tool. In

addition interested parties are invited to participate in the development of other language versions.
